In addition to many other local performers, we are excited to welcome back the J Love Band, one of the hottest Funk, Soul and R&B bands in the Kansas City area playing music from legendary artist such as Marin Gaye, Bill Withers, Al Green, Aretha Franklin, Stevie Wonder, Etta James, and many others! Finishing out the night will be The Cherry Pistols. Since 2012, The Cherry Pistols have become known as one of Missouri's most electrifying and premier party bands! Serving up a delicious mix of rock, pop, and funk from the 70's and 80's with sprinkles of the 90's classics to hits of today!
